

GL Ready 1.2 Release Notes June 2020

In October 2019, we launched our brand-new testing platform, GL Ready, which incorporated our much-loved Lucid tests: Rapid, CoPS and LASS 8-11.

Since the launch we have used initial customer feedback to guide and prioritise further developments to the platform.

New features

Release 1.2 features the following to provide more detailed reporting:

Additional scores

We have updated the reports to include five of the most popular scoring formats, allowing users to view their data in different ways:

- Standard Age Scores (already in place)
- Stanines
- National Percentile Rank (Lucid customers will know this as 'Centile')
- T-score
- Z-score

NB. Neither the test, the scores nor the scoring have changed. The scores are just presented in additional ways.

The student's age at date of testing is now included in reports

This will be helpful for putting some of the new score formats into context.

Colour coded guidance to aid interpretation and next steps

You will now find enhanced guidance for interpreting the reports. With colour coded risk statements for each subtest to enable you to quickly assess the needs of each student. In addition, we have created lookup tables that will guide you through the steps of implementing support for your students.

Student ID

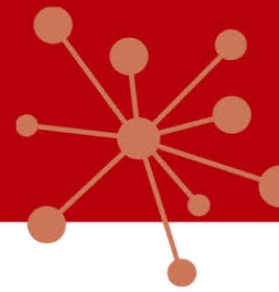
We have added student IDs to the pupil information table; helping teachers in cases when there are two or more students with the same name.

Ability to view multiple reports

When viewing reports for multiple students, you can now select 'view all' to see all selected reports in one document, this will mean you can scroll through reports and save or print them in bulk.

Ability to export to CSV

This will be helpful for schools who collate scores in their own reporting systems.

Improvements

We have made a few changes to the appearance of the reports.

Report title

We have updated the report titles to make it clearer what is being reported, particularly for those unfamiliar with the tests e.g. parents.

Greater emphasis on links to manuals

We have emphasised that it is possible to access the manuals and support directly from the online reports.

Created a more professional look to the reports

We have made some cosmetic adjustments to the rendering of the reports, for a more professional look and easier viewing.

Described the risk arrow in Rapid

On the Rapid report, we have changed the wording to better describe the function of the arrow (which indicates the end of the graph showing greater risk of dyslexia).

Updated support pages

We have updated the support pages for Rapid, CoPS and LASS.
